Steps 2 Success:

- Maximum size approx. A3 (30cm x 42cm)

- Well-presented show that you have made a real effort!
- Include your name and class (back of your work)
- Entries can be submitted to your class teacher at any time up to and including the day before half term – Friday 19th October

Your teachers will support you in class by explaining the competition and discussing the meaning of 'motivates' and 'inspires'. The ideas are down to you!

The competition will be judged and awards given during the first week back at school after our half term holiday. Time to get working on your creations.....

Remember that each entry is worth 10 house points!
