Special congratulations to Stanley H, Lucas G, Mason D and Emilie JVR their efforts won them a place at the National Cross Country Finals where they finished in the top third a great achievement!
- In March, the street dance club performed at The Grange School in Aylesbury. They performed two numbers which were very well received by the audience! It was a fun evening full of dancing.
- Finally, the children have thoroughly enjoyed practising for and taking part in the skipping world record. In total, the pupils of WJS completed 383,271 skips! We are still eagerly awaiting the national total to see if the record has been broken. Fingers crossed!
