This was our final week of focusing on Resilience. As well as thinking about the resilience needed to achieve our goals, we have thought about the sacrifices that we need to make along our journey. Children have been challenged to think about small sacrifices they could make over Easter, simple things that would help their family and friends.

Easter Service

Thank you to everyone who came along to support the children in church on Tuesday. We were treated to a fantastic re-telling of the Easter story through art, poetry, music and drama. Thank you also to the staff for all their hard work in preparing the children.

Punctuality

We regularly monitor the children's attendance and punctuality and have seen a rise in the number of children arriving late for school this term. A small percentage of might have been to be due to the weather conditions, however we know that this does not explain the majority of cases. Please note that children should be at the school gate by 8.50am each morning. Please allow extra time for traffic if you are travelling by car and encourage children to leave home in good time. We will be monitoring punctuality closely after Easter.

Building Works

Our building works are progressing to plan and we will see some classroom moves over the coming weeks to allow further development of the extension of South End:

- 3W will relocate to the Studio from 16 April
- 3S will relocate to the ICT suite from 16 April
- 4J will relocate to North End new block from 2 May
- 4S will relocate to North End new block from 2 May
- 3C will relocate to old 4S classroom from 2 May
- 3J will relocate to old 4J classroom from 2 May



In advance of the ICT suite changing use, we have recycled the old desktop PCs and purchased a trolley of 30 laptops. These have already been in use over the past 2 weeks, alongside the existing trolleys of iPads.

We are also looking forward to reclaiming some of the playground at the end of April, when the temporary roadway will be removed back to our boundary with John Hampden. Hopefully the weather will improve sufficiently for us to be able to use the field again early next term which will also help make break times less cramped for all!

ParentPay

We are aware that a number of children were disappointed today not to receive hot dogs. It appears that there has been a technical error on ParentPay's website meaning that several orders were not received by the school. We will be taking this up with ParentPay and unfilled orders will of course be refunded. In the meantime, we apologise for any upset and/or inconvenience caused by this situation.
