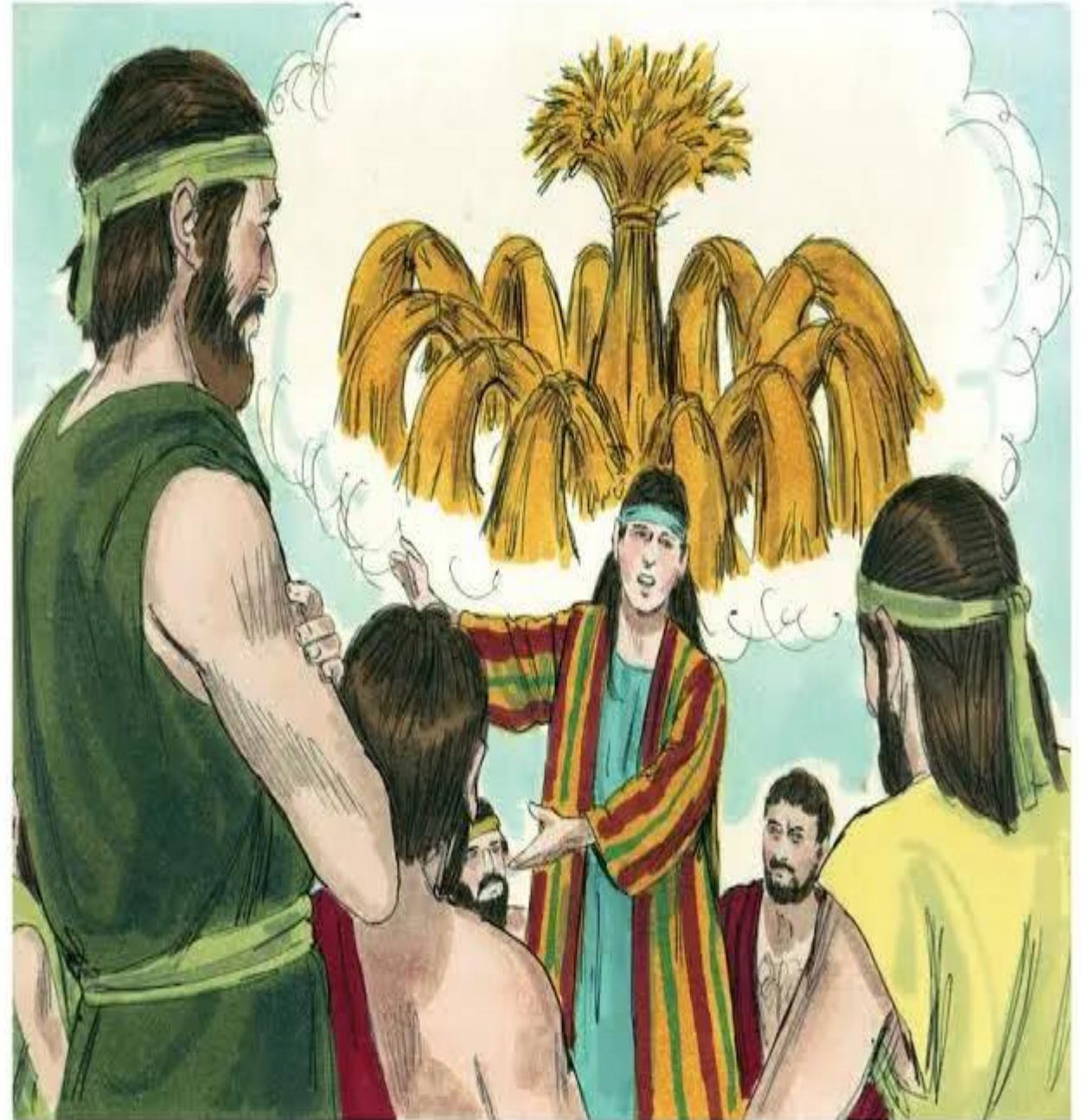
STORY OF JOSEPH

How do you respond to someone who is boasting or giving you news you don't want to hear?

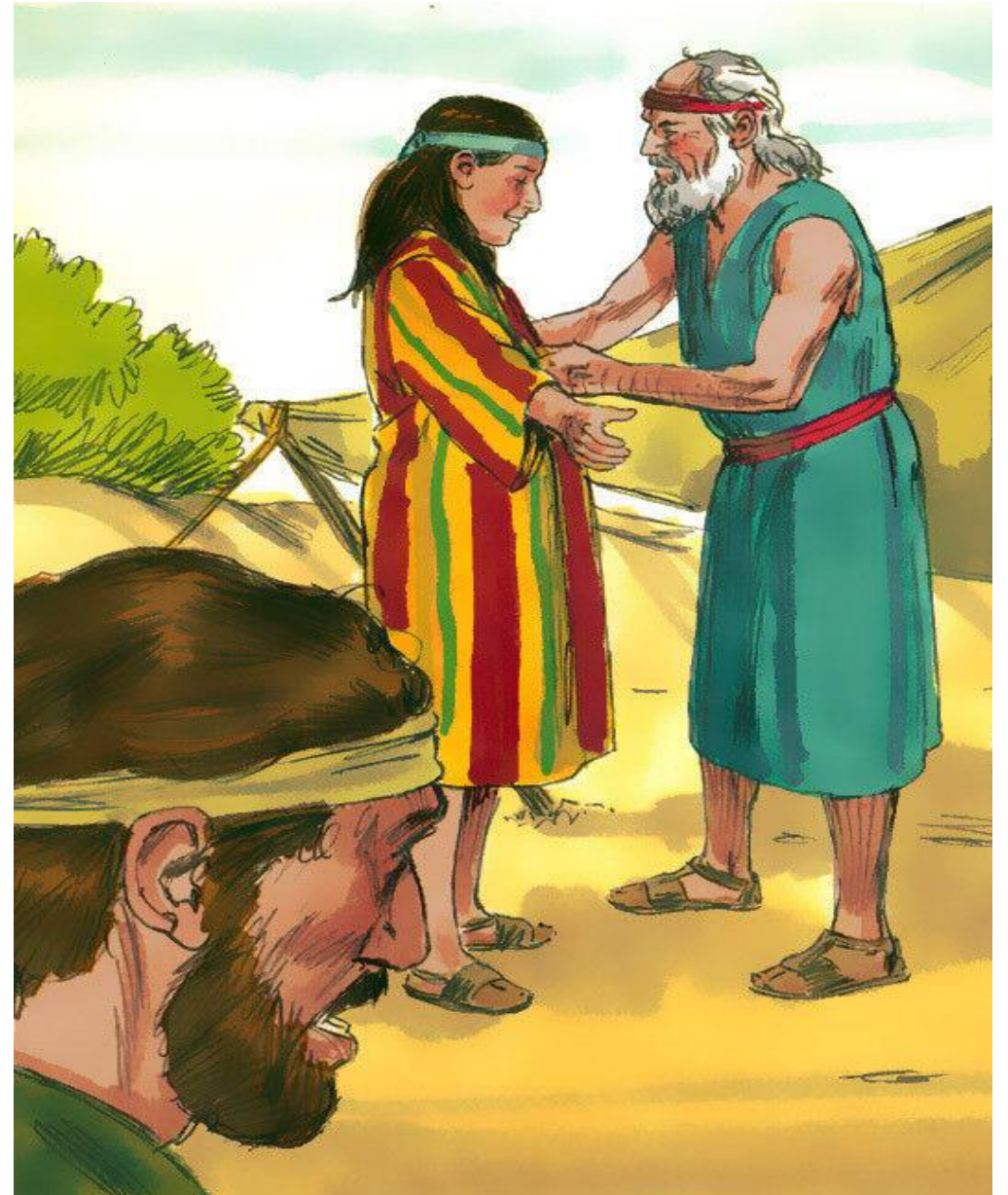


The Coat of Many Colours
