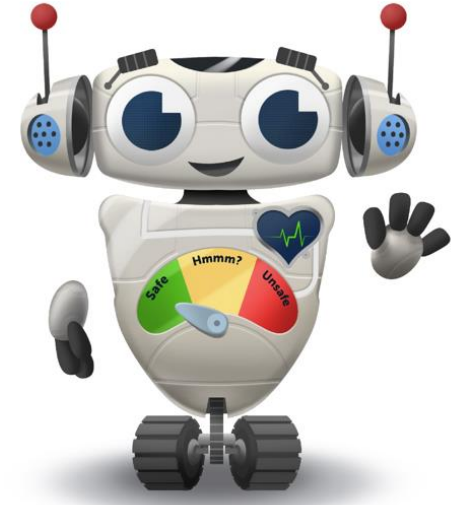

something is not quite right.

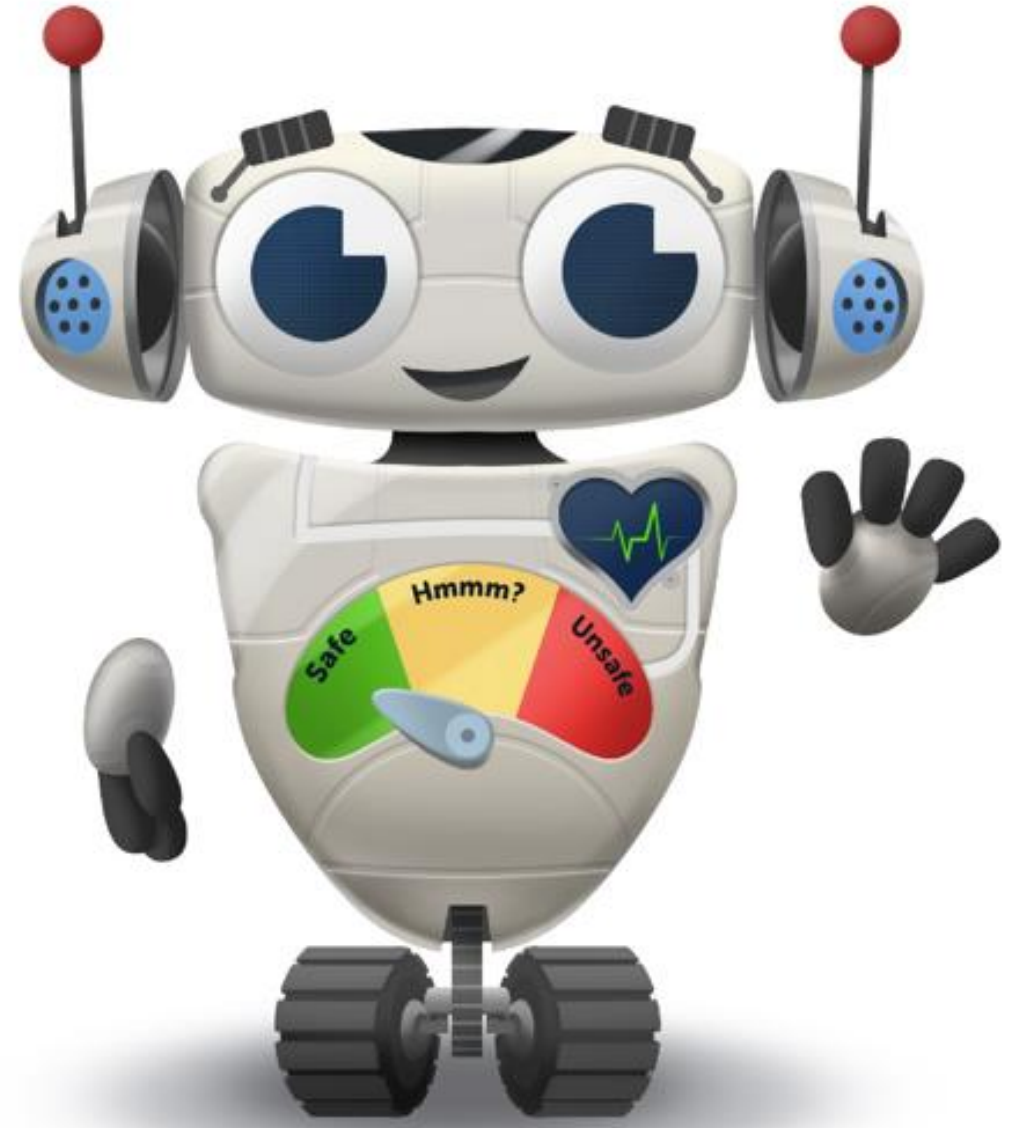
Wherever clever goes,
