Tribute to HM Queen Elizabeth II

We met together as a school this morning to commemorate the life of The Queen. Mr Kynaston read through text he had prepared, taking time to explain some of the more difficult elements of the message (the text of the speech is attached as a pdf).

Children were respectful throughout the short service, which included a 2 minute silence when everyone was asked to reflect on what they had learned about Queen Elizabeth II through their work on the jubilee, or to offer a prayer in support of her family. Mr Kynaston then shared a prayer as a candle was lit.

We are planning an adaptation of lessons on the day of the state funeral, anticipated to be Monday 19 September. This will be an opportunity for children to celebrate the life of Queen Elizbeth II. Schools will remain open throughout the period of national mourning.

Uniform
