

Steps to Success:

- 1. Choose a story from one of the six major world religions (Christianity, Islam, Judaism, Buddhism, Sikhism or Hinduism). Please see below for some suggested links. You can read a story, watch a video of your chosen story or listen to an audio transcript.
- 2. Think about the key message/moral of the story.
- 3. Link the message of the story to at least one of the 4Rs (Respect, Reflection, Resilience or Responsibility).
- 4. Think about how you would like to present your work. It can be:
 - A piece of writing
 - An A3 piece of art work
 - A 3D model (up to A3 size)
 - A story board
 - A creative poster
 - Alternatively, any other creative way you can think of.
- 5. Your work must include:
 - The story or a summary of the story
 - Which religion the story is from (you may show this through a religious symbol)
 - The key message
 - Which R it is linked to
- 6. Hand in your entries to your class teacher by Friday 25 October. Remember to put your full name and class on your entry.

Remember:

- Each entry is worth 10 house points.
- There will be first, second and third prizes for each year group.

We look forward to seeing your creative entries to enhance our 'Trees of Faith' display.
