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Welcome Back

The summer holiday seems almost a distant memory as we end our first full week back at school. Children have settled well into their new surroundings and are hard at work already, embarking on their current units of work. Our building works are nearing completion and children are benefitting from the larger classrooms and much increased playground space. We look forward to welcoming you to the Meet the Teacher session in two weeks when you will have a chance to see some of the new facilities and meet your child's class teacher. Thank you to the PTA who will be providing refreshments in the hall at this session.

Extended Learning

As well as developing good learning habits and responsibility through completing their work outside the classroom, we encourage our children to foster a sense of curiosity and to try new things. This year we want to give pupils more opportunities to learn about the wider curriculum through our extended learning programme. As well as embedding core knowledge and skills, we will be encouraging all pupils to enter a half termly competition, each one focusing on a different area of the curriculum. Children will be given up to four weeks to complete their entry, which will be rewarded by 10 house points. Further awards will be given to those who demonstrate outstanding effort or for those entries that are highly commended. Our first competition will be all about Growth Mindset and motivation (look out for an email on Monday!).

Extra-curricular Activities

This year's booklet outlining the range of before and after school club activities was sent home on Monday. If you have yet to return your child's choices, please ensure the form is brought into school by Monday latest. Confirmed places will be sent home via your during w/b 24 September, together with information from external providers where applicable.

Uniform

Please help us by ensuring that your child is wearing the correct uniform at all times. In particular, pupils should be wearing black school shoes and have long hair tied up with a simple tie (black, grey or red with no decorations or ears. Jewellery should not be worn, other than a wristwatch or one earring in each earlobe if ears are pierced. Watches and earrings must be removed for PE. NB Children should have their full PE kit in school at all times; lessons are timetabled on certain days but these can change due to other events taking place in school.

Please also ensure all your child's property (uniform, coat, PE kit, shoes, lunchboxes, etc) is clearly marked with their full name. Firmly fastened labels are preferred, however if you choose to use a pen, please check items regularly to ensure the name hasn't washed off and is still clearly visible. It is also helpful to remove any old names (siblings or friends) as this can be very confusing!

Punctuality

Children need to be in school by 8.50am each morning in order that they can make the very best start to the day. We will be monitoring punctuality and attendance closely this year.

Medicines in School

From time to time your child may require ad-hoc medication in school, eg antibiotics. A reminder that all medicines must be delivered to the office by an adult (in the original packaging showing the prescription details) and a consent form must be completed. NB Only 4 dose a day antibiotics can be administered in school.
