



### Parking too near to the campus entrance puts children in danger and may put the School Crossing Patroller at risk. Parking on the schools' campus is prohibited during the school day.

The area outside our school campus is busy in the morning and at the end of the school day. Keeping this area clear allows children and parents walking in and out of school to cross safely, where they can see and be seen by approaching traffic.

# By signing the Parents' Parking Promise, parents agree:

- > Not to drive in the Active Travel Zone during peak times (drop off/pick up)
- $\succ$  Not to park on the double yellow lines or hatched area at the campus entrance
- > Not to park on the 'School Keep Clear' zig-zags
- Always to park outside the Active Travel Zone, ie Wharf Road and Manor Road and side roads (please see your MAP leaflet for Park & Stride points)
