Campus Safety

Please also remember that unauthorised vehicles should not be entering the campus during the school day - we have noticed a number of people accessing the site early to avoid the barrier. We strive to teach your children to follow the school rules and it can be very frustrating when parents flout these rules. If you do have to drive to collect your child, please park away from the campus and walk so that everyone can get to and from school safely. Thank you for your cooperation.
