

Walk to School Week, 21-25 October 2019



Next week is Walk to School Week and our school is participating in **HAPPY SHOESDAY** on Wednesday to promote sustainable travel to school while also raising funds for road safety.

How it works

Pupils wear their happy shoes, walk to school and bring in a suggested 50p to donate to our chosen charity, Living Streets.

Your happy shoes could be anything from school shoes, trainers, wellies or boots - or get creative and change the laces, add beads, feathers, wings or stickers. (NB You still need to wear your shoes at break and lunchtime, so make sure they are safe!) Our Junior Road Safety officers gave a presentation in assembly today to tell the children all about it and give them some ideas.

Where the money goes

Your donations will go to Living Streets, the UK charity for everyday walking - working to make streets safer for all since 1929, celebrating ninety years of road safety initiatives this year. Living Streets created the WOW Travel Tracker, which the children use in class every day to record their journeys.
