COVID Update

Whilst we are making every effort to make things as normal as possible for children, life at school is not normal. Staff are working harder than ever just to cope with the daily demands of keeping everyone safe. As the pandemic continues we must take care that we do not become complacent, especially as fatigue sets in.

We have already revisited expectations with staff this week and will be doing the same with children throughout next week. Please support us by ensuring that children understand the importance of regular handwashing and that they wash their hands regularly at home to reinforce good habits.

We have not needed to send bubbles home yet and we hope that we do not have to do so, though this may be well beyond our control. We are introducing new measures for staff as from Monday 16 November:

- The number of staff outside school at the start and the end of the day will be reduced and they will be wearing masks
- Staff who are working within 1 metre of a child for more than one minute are advised to wear a visor
- Staff supervising busy areas within the school are advised to wear a visor

We continue to ask parents to wear a mask when dropping off or collecting. Children may wear a mask if they wish to (we asks that a new mask is worn each day or that reusable ones are appropriately rinsed at the end of the day).
