Core Subjects

MATHS:

- Using our knowledge of place value to add and subtract 10, 100 and 1000 (possibly larger numbers) both mentally and in formal written methods
- Using our knowledge of addition and subtraction in the context of money
- Looking again at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and right angles
- Learning and practising multiplication and division methods
- Practising our times tables until we are confident of all tables up to and including 12 x 12

ENGLISH:

- Using stories with a familiar setting for narrative writing such as Little Red Riding Hood and Goldilocks and the Three Bears
- Learning by heart poems written by other authors and performing them to an audience
- Writing our own versions of these poems and performing them to an audience
- Learning about and writing information texts about John Hampden using our own research of the history of Wendover as our influence

SCIENCE:

As scientists we will be finding out about forces and magnets (including springs)

We will be investigating:

- What is force (including pushes and pulls)
- How forces can be useful
- What is magnetism
- Creating our own magnets
- Poles which either attract or repel
