### **COVID Update**

The DfE have asked school to share the this information about covid vaccines.

Children aged 5 to 11 years who are in a clinical risk group or who live with someone who is immunosuppressed can get the COVID-19 vaccine, in line with advice set out by the <u>Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI)</u>. Eligible children include those with diabetes, immunosuppression, learning disabilities, and other conditions as outlined by the <u>UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) in the Green Book</u>.

Vaccinations help to increase protection against COVID-19, which is particularly important for those with underlying health conditions.

Further information is available in the <u>guide for parents of children aged 5 to 11 years</u> published by UKHSA. We have published some <u>frequently asked questions</u> on the vaccination programme including information on eligibility, accessibility and advice for parents of children at high risk from COVID-19.

We are trying to remove as many restrictions as we can in school whilst also keeping a close eye on the number of positive cases.

## **School Trips**

We rely on parental contributions towards school trips which support the termly topics.

Unfortunately, we have received a lack of financial support for recent events leaving us with significant shortfalls. This week we considered cancelling a forthcoming Yr 5 trip as initial uptake was only 30%. Thankfully, we are now in a position to confirm it will be going ahead.
