COVID Update

Please read the following important information regarding tracing during the next 6 days (18-23 December). If your child tests positive for coronavirus, and developed symptoms within 48 hours of leaving school on Thursday 17 December, email <u>admin@wendoverjunior.co.uk</u> stating: your child's name and class; when the test was taken. If your child develops symptoms after 48 hours from the last day of term, do not contact the school but follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace instead. The school will continue to work with the PHE with tracking up until Wednesday 23 December.

You may have heard that testing will be rolled out in schools after Christmas. The priority will be secondary schools with primary schools joining in February. We will send more detailed information to parents once we have received further information and training in January.
