Y6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP, 10-14 June 2019

We are delighted to inform you that we have booked a 4 night residential educational activity course with In2action at Gaveston Hall in West Sussex. The trip will be taking place from 10-14 June 2019 and there is space for every child in Year 6 to attend if they wish.

Residential trips are an optional but invaluable part of the national curriculum. Your child's learning will be extended beyond the classroom and they will develop their personal and social qualities, grow their self-confidence and have lots of fun. The team building exercises will benefit the children and encourage them to develop useful skills as they prepare for the transition to secondary school.

The total cost of the trip is £285 which includes return travel by coach, insurance, full board and accommodation, as well as a packed programme of activities. To guarantee your child's place on the trip a non-refundable deposit of £45 is required by Friday 19 October via ParentPay, along with initial consent. Three further instalments of £80 will then be required to be paid online by Friday 14 December, Friday 15 February and Friday 5 April. The payment scheme is set up on ParentPay with these dates and amounts.

Children who are eligible for free school meals can be fully funded to participate in this trip, however you will still need to let us know that you wish your child to attend, either by logging on to ParentPay to give consent or by sending an email to finance@wendoverjunoir.co.uk. Part funding may also be available for families on low incomes; to discuss your situation in confidence, please contact Catriona Martin, School Business Manager, at finance@wendoverjunior.co.uk or by calling the school and selection option 4.

We will arrange a parents' meeting in the spring term to give you more details about the trip and activities on offer.
