Taking responsibility and caring for our environment.

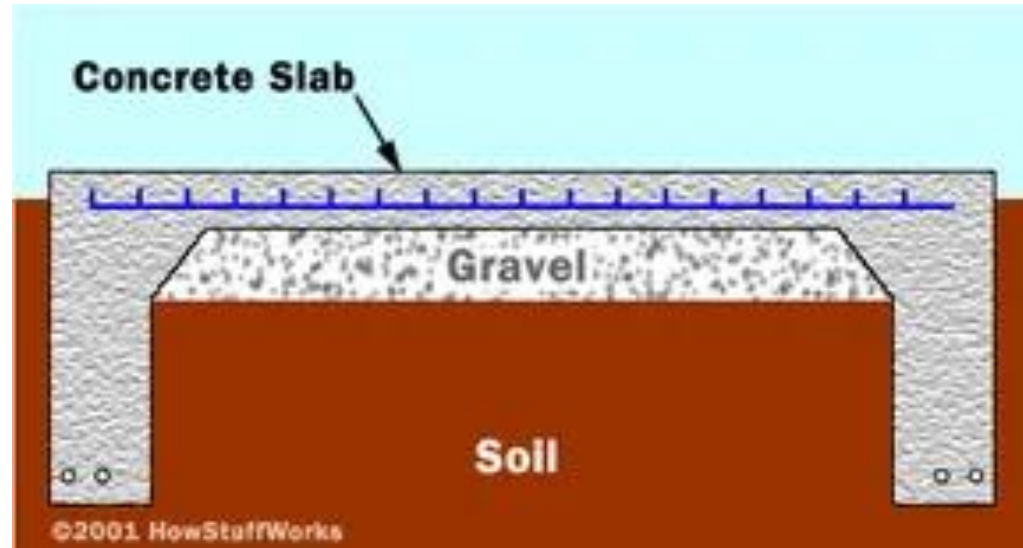

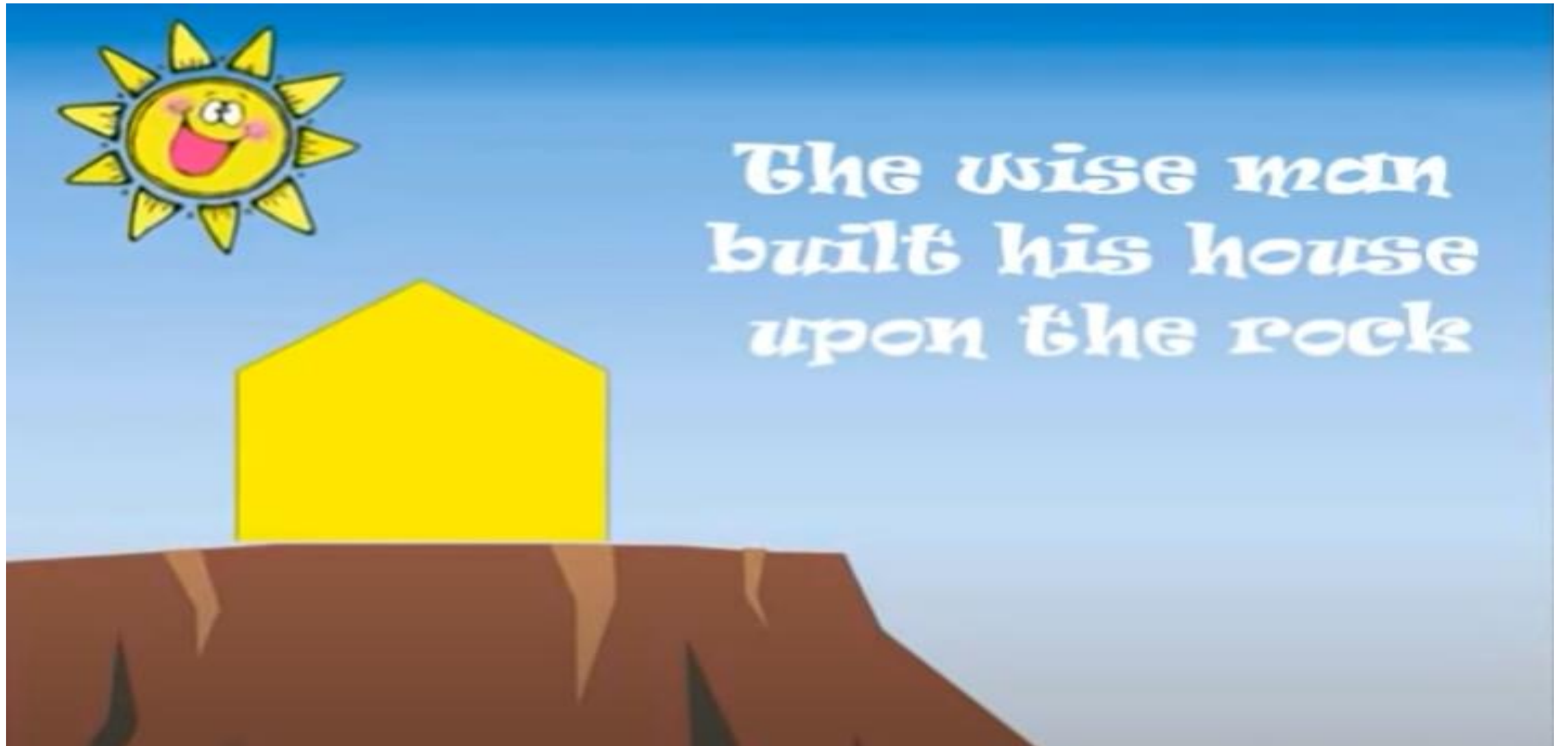
