Swim Instructors Needed

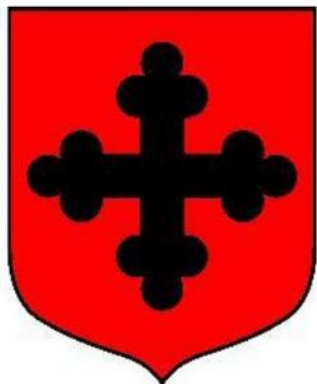
We are looking for three qualified swim instructors to support our school swimming lessons on Friday afternoons at the Wendover Pool.
