We are continuing to explore the school vision and values. Last week, we focussed on reflection and this week we have thought about resilience. We agreed that resilience is not about the times we fall over, but the times we get back up.

Children have thought about times that they found difficult or things that they find difficult to do. We then considered how different strategies might be used to help us overcome our challenges.

Weekly Highlights

Year 3

Y3 children read thoughtful poems and prayers about Gratitude in the church this week, demonstrating extra resilience and enthusiasm during the singing parts of the service

Children are continuing to enjoy and explore Katie in London during English lessons

Children have started their next maths topic, addition and subtraction after working hard on their end of unit assessments

Year 4

The children have shown great resilience this week when planning and writing their persuasive letters to an author. They have also worked hard to secure their rounding strategies to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. In RSHE, the children looked at respectful ways to say no to a friend while recognising occasions when they need to stand up to peer pressure and say no when something doesn't feel right.

Year 5 enjoyed their walk to St Mary's for our Harvest Festival on Tuesday. They showed how resilient they were when the sound wasn't cooperating as well as it could, and still sang beautifully. In Maths they learned about rounding numbers to estimate amounts – a handy skill to use when you go shopping!

Year 6

We enjoyed a wonderful Harvest Service at St Mary's Church this week, during which Year 6 presented their take on the importance of the Harvest Festival. They did us proud. Well done everyone.

It was lovely to see so many parents supporting Harvest Festival this week. Thank you also for the many positive comments, not least about the singing.

Not having the music was a timely reminder that we don't always get exactly what we want, or what we planned for, but often we get what we need.

The sale is in school at lunchtime on Friday 10 October.


If children have any pocket-money they can spare then please remind them to bring this in; please try to provide change (50p or £1 coins would be really helpful.
