Please remember to check the school uniform policy when replacing clothing:

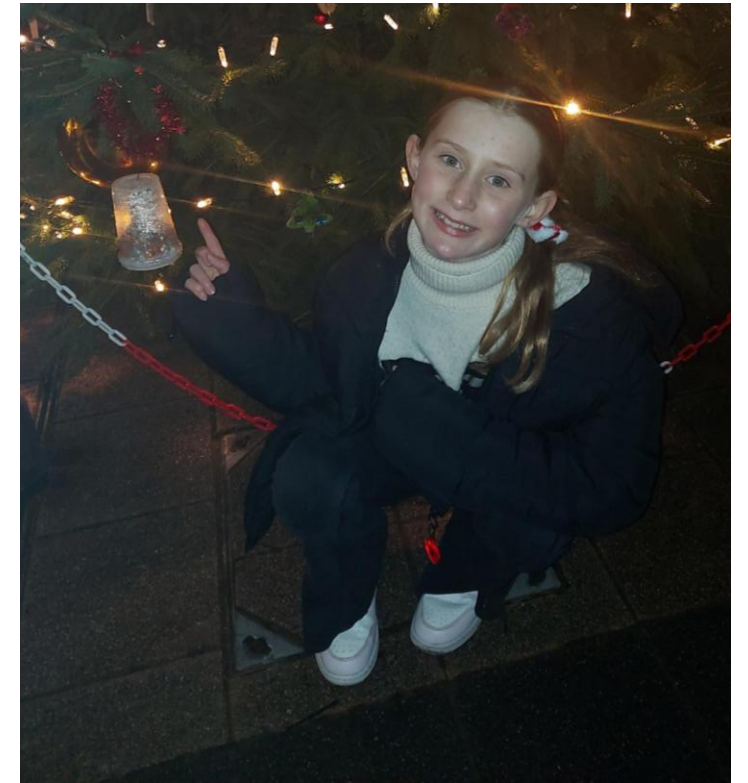

Swim Instructors Needed

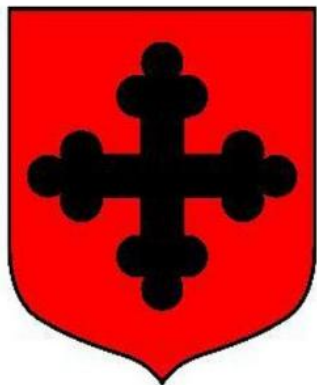
We are looking for three qualified swim instructors to support our school swimming lessons on Friday afternoons at the Wendover Pool.
